

WHAT CAN I POWER WITH MY TRUCK?

With your charged F-150® Lightning™ and Home Integration System, you can provide up to 9.6kW of power at any given time to your home's backed up devices. What does this mean? In a typical* home, this might include:

ESSENTIALS SUCH AS:

- Lights
- WiFi
- Refrigerator
- Freezer
- Outlets (120V)
 (i.e. phone & computer charging)

PLUS ONE OR MORE HIGH POWER APPLIANCES, SUCH AS:

- Cooking stove/oven
- · Water heater
- Sump pump
- Washer/dryer
- Heating or A/C[†]

Note: gas appliances that require electricity to start can also be backed up.*

HOW LONG CAN I POWER MY HOME WITH MY TRUCK?

STANDARD RANGE:

- Up to 2 days
- Up to **10** days powering a refrigerator

EXTENDED RANGE:

- Up to 3 days
- Up to 10 days powering a refrigerator

WHAT CAN'T I POWER WITH MY TRUCK?

Very high power draws such as the following cannot be backed up by your F-150® Lightning™:

- Hot tubs and spas
- · Pool equipment
- EV chargers

- Multiple A/C or heating systems
- Elevators
- Medical devices
