Post-Accident Checklist

Use this checklist immediately after an accident, but only once you have ensured the immediate safety of yourself and others. If any persons are injured or require immediate medical assistance, contact first responders before taking any other action. It's designed to guide you through gathering essential information and documenting the scene for insurance, police, and personal records.

Information Gathering and Documentation

Call the police and provide a detailed account of the incident.

Photograph the other party's driver's license.

Photograph the other party's insurance information.

Determine if the driver is also the vehicle's owner.

Record the names and contact information for all passengers involved.

Record the names and contact information of any witnesses at the scene.

Take photos of the accident scene, including vehicle placement, posted speed limits, and any contributing factors.

Capture images of the license plates of all vehicles involved.

Reporting and Follow-Up

If a police report is generated, request the report number and name of the officer who took the report.

Obtain information about the tow company if any vehicles were towed.

Confirm the hospital where any injured individuals were transported.
